

NASA Education FALL Stand Down March 8th & 9th 2010 Metra Ticket Availability

OGILVIE Transportation Center – Madison and Canal Street in Chicago

- Union Pacific/Northwest line Chicago to Harvard – **It is very important to specify the Northwest Line.**
- Train usually leaves from Track 8 or 10, but look on the main board when you enter Ogilvie Station- **please arrive prior to 7:20 a.m.**
- All participants for the Stand Down will be meeting on the tracks. Look for individuals with a clipboard that says NASA Education Stand Down. If you have a disabled train pass for the metra you may board without seeing NASA Staff. You must have a VA ID card or your DD214 in order to receive free transportation.
- Transportation will be for **MONDAY ONLY** so attendees will want to be there to get their tickets prior to approx 7:20 as they will be getting on the 7:30 train. The return ticket will be distributed at the Stand Down for the return trip. **THERE WILL BE NO TICKETS AVAILABLE AFTER 7:20 a.m.**
- If you don't make it to the 7:30 a.m. train the next train isn't until 9:00 a.m. and no tickets will be available for that train.
- Once on the train the attendees will need to **get off at the Cary stop** and where shuttle vans will be going back and forth to YMCA Camp Algonquin. They will have signs on them.
